Community health impact assessment is a way to bring the health concerns of the community forward in discussions of public policy. Since our health and well-being are influenced by a wide range of factors, both within and outside the health sector, community health impact assessment is useful in examining any activity (policy, program, project or service) that will affect the community.

Community health impact assessment is based on the idea that the development of healthy public policy requires broad community participation.

Community health impact assessment allows communities to:

- estimate the effect that a particular activity will have on the health and well-being of the community
- identify things to do that will maximize the benefits and minimize the harm of that activity

As a result of this training, participants will:

- gain an understanding of the social, economic, environmental and cultural determinants of health
- gain an understanding of the impact of programs, policy and planning on well-being
- develop an understanding of the of the history, process and theory underlying the Community Health Impact Assessment process
- develop skills in facilitating a process for community members to develop their own Community Health Impact Assessment tool
- develop facilitation skills using the tool to assess the potential impact of an activity on the health of community members
